

A Message from St.Paul Public Health

Dear Parent/Guardian:

As always Public Health Nurses require parental consent before providing any service to children in schools.

As outlined in the provincial <u>School Immunization Standard</u> (<u>albertahealthservices.ca</u>) once consent is obtained from the parent/guardian, it remains in effect until consent is withdrawn or the student's condition has changed. To be clear, consents signed during one school year may be used until the immunization/immunization series is complete, as long as the consent has not been withdrawn by the parent/guardian and the student's condition has not changed.

Interruptions in the delivery of routine school immunizations due to the COVID-19 pandemic have made catch-up immunizations in many schools a necessity, therefore our Public Health school teams may be immunizing some students using consents obtained in previous years.

Although COVID-19 vaccines have been shown to be safe and effective vaccines, they will **NOT** be offered during routine school immunization clinics.

What to expect for your school immunization

The school immunization program

Each year, the Alberta Health Services Public Health School Immunization Program reviews immunization records of students in grades 1, 6 and 9. Parents and guardians will get information about the vaccines the student needs and instructions for completing the consent forms for them to get these vaccines in school. Students are immunized in the school by a team of public health nurses who are trained to support students to have a positive immunization experience.

Alberta Health Services treats every person with respect and dignity. It is important to us that you feel safe using healthcare services wherever they are provided.

Preparing for your school vaccine

- Wear short sleeves or loose-fitting sleeves because you will get the vaccine in your upper arm.
- If you are worried about getting a needle, nurses at our clinics are trained to help you feel more comfortable. To learn more, visit <u>ahs.ca/vaccinecomfort</u> or talk to your nurse.

Checking in

- When you come for your vaccine, you will check in with a staff member.
- All your information, including what vaccine you are receiving, is kept private.
- When it is time for your immunization, you will meet with your nurse.

During your immunization

- Your nurse will only give you vaccines that are recommended for you and that your parent or guardian have given consent for.
- Your nurse will talk to you about your health to make sure it's safe for you to get immunized. They will ask questions about medicines you take, health conditions, including pregnancy if you're in grade 7 or older, allergies, and any reactions you've had to vaccines in

the past. The nurse will also ask you about other immunizations you've had recently. Your parent or guardian may have already provided some of this information on the form they returned.

- You can ask the nurse any questions you have about the immunization.
- Your nurse will ask if you are ready to get immunized.
 It's okay to feel afraid or nervous. The nurse will help you to use comfort strategies during your immunization. Then they will clean a spot on your upper arm and give you the immunization.
- You will get a record of your immunization to take home. The immunization details will be saved to your personal electronic health records. A copy of all the immunizations you got in school can be provided on request. Children age 14 years and older can access an electronic copy of their immunizations by registering for a MyHealth Records account at

MyHealth.Alberta.ca/myhealthrecords. Children under age 14 years, can contact their local public health or community health centre to get a copy of their immunizations.

After your immunization

- You need to stay in the school for 15 minutes after your immunization. This short wait is important in case you have a rare but serious allergic reaction called anaphylaxis. If anaphylaxis happens, the nurse can give you medicine to treat the symptoms.
- Please let a teacher or staff member know if you're not feeling well so they can get the nurse to help you.




