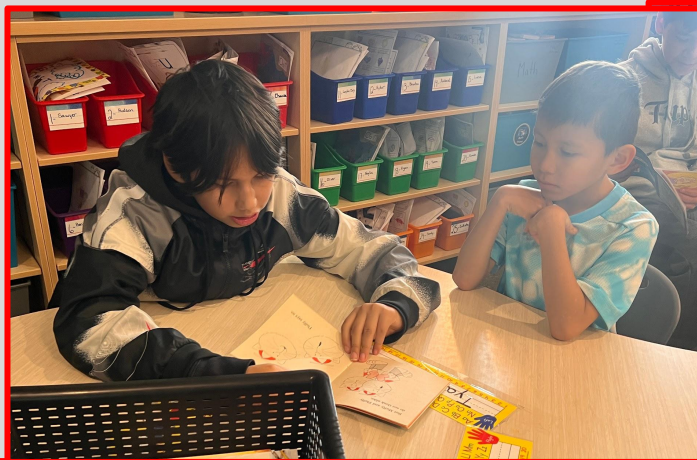

## Citadel Field Trip



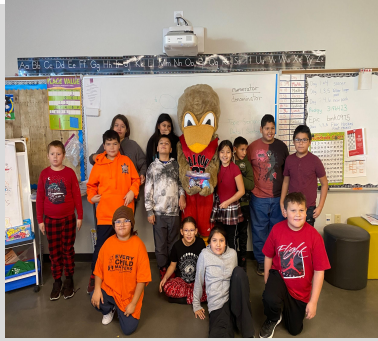
