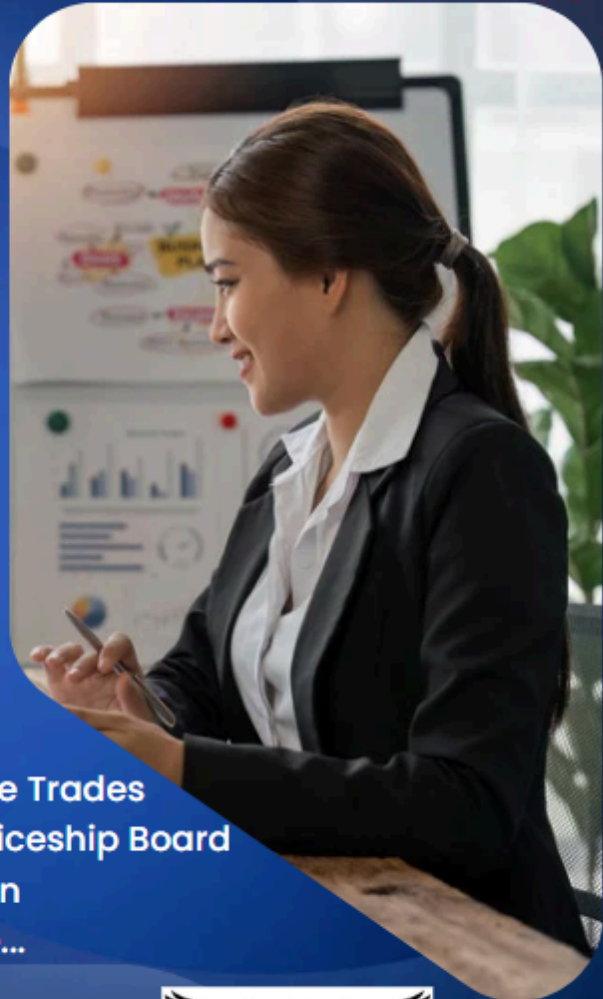

Ashmont Goes Skiing!

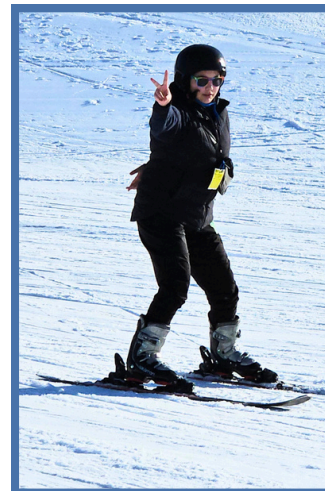
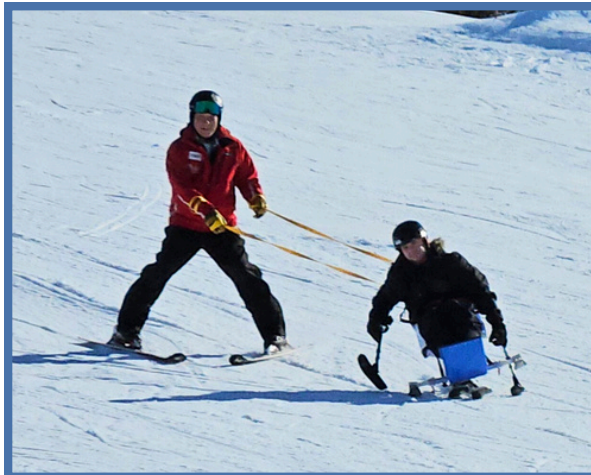
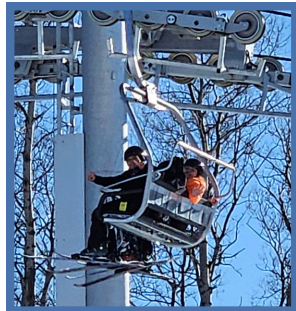
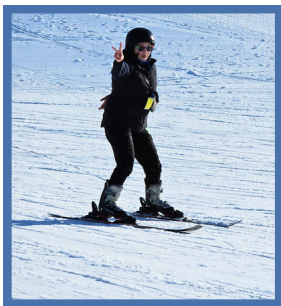

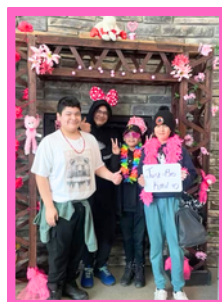
FALCON BASKETBALL
