



- explore their grief
- share their experiences with other kids who also have had losses
- learn tools to help them cope
- remember and honour their loved ones; and
- give them hope for the future along with all the "fun" camp activities.

It is our goal to provide an atmosphere of safety and trust, unconditional support, kindness and respect. This is a place where kids may come alone as strangers, and leave together as a "family". Our team of staff and volunteers is ready and waiting!

- A Camper Application to be filled out by your child it is important that we
 get her/his feelings and views on coming to a bereavement camp.


